

Terms & Conditions

Background

The Genesis School-gen Super Teacher competition (**Competition**) is aimed at finding two ‘Super Teachers’ who inspire and motivate students in science, technology, engineering or maths and rewarding them with a trip to attend the Space Exploration Educators Conference in 2020 at the Space Centre in Houston, Texas USA. There will be one prize for a Primary / Intermediate teacher and one for a Secondary teacher. All nominators will also go in the draw to win a School-gen prize pack.

- These terms (**Terms**) govern the Competition.
- The promoter of the Competition is Genesis Energy Limited (**Genesis**).
- The Competition is open from Monday, 14 October 2019 to 5pm Friday, 1 November 2019.

Eligibility

- The Competition is open to any New Zealand qualified and registered teacher who is currently teaching in a New Zealand school.
- Genesis reserves the right, at any time, to disqualify or exclude an entry from the Competition that is not in accordance with these Terms.
- Genesis may, at its sole and absolute discretion, reject any entry that it deems to be inappropriate, invalid, incomplete or is contrary to New Zealand law.
- Genesis is not liable or responsible for any late, lost, misdirected or incorrect entries, or any technical malfunction, delay or loss of data that may result in the failure or delay of the entry being submitted into the Competition.

Competition Details

- To enter the Competition a person must nominate a teacher in either the Primary (Year 0 – 8) and Secondary (Year 9-13) categories via the Genesis School-gen Competition page. For the nomination to be valid, all information requested must be supplied.
- Once the nomination has been made the person nominating the teacher will also go in the draw to win a School-gen prize pack.
- Once entries close, all nominations will be reviewed, and a shortlist created. For all shortlisted nominations, the nominator, nominee, and the principal of the school where the nominee teaches, will be contacted for further information by the Genesis School-gen team.
- The winners of both the Primary and Secondary categories will be contacted by 22 November 2019.
- The judges’ decision is final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Prizes

- Both the Primary and Secondary winners will receive:
 - return domestic flights to Auckland (if not based in Auckland);
 - return international flights from Auckland to Houston, Texas, USA;
 - a three-day conference pass to the Space Exploration Educators Conference from the 6th to the 8th of February 2020;
 - NZ\$500 Prezzy Card or similar;
 - accommodation in Houston, Texas to coincide with the arrival to, and departure from, the conference.
- All other shortlisted nominees will receive an Apple iPad, the specifications of which will be at the discretion of the judges.
- All nominators will go in the draw to win one of three Genesis School-gen prize pack comprising of a Sphero Bolt, Genesis School-gen t-shirt and Genesis School-gen cap.
- A prize will be forfeited if a winner:
 - is unable to be contacted by Genesis by 6 December 2019;

- does not meet the eligibility criteria for the Competition;
 - is found to have breached any of these Terms;
 - cannot participate in the Competition for any reason.
- If a prize is forfeited, Genesis may select an alternative winner.
- No component of the prizes can be transferred or redeemed for cash.
